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through different legal and criminological angles and perspectives this book addresses the controversial question of whether prisoners should have the right to vote as well as the optimal modalities for such a vote by adopting a comparative approach to explore the legal systems of very different jurisdictions such as the former eastern bloc england ireland the usa and france the book reveals a recent trend in opening up the right to vote it also looks at the recommendations of international and european institutions which while relatively cautious nevertheless support such progress examining the issue from a criminological viewpoint the book investigates the role that prisoners votes could play in the social integration of these individuals into the community through political inclusion as citizens offering legal theoretical and empirical bases it blends a variety of perspectives to help readers establish an understanding of how prisoners voting could contribute to

improving their attachment to society and its values concise and direct prisoners vote will be of great interest to upper level students and scholars of law criminology sociology criminal justice and political science it should also appeal to practitioners working in the criminal justice system and policy makers reflecting on whether and how to open the right to vote to prisoners

stephen k medvic s campaigns and elections addresses two distinct but related aspects of american electoral democracy both the processes that constitute campaigns and elections and the players who are involved in addition to this balanced coverage on process and actors it also gives equal billing to both campaigns and elections and to contests for both legislative and executive positions at the national and state and local level the book starts by providing students with the conceptual distinctions between what happens in an election and the campaigning that proceeds it significant attention is devoted to setting up the context for these campaigns and elections by covering the rules of the game in the american electoral system as well as aspects of election administration and the funding of elections then the book systematically covers the actors at every level candidates and their organizations parties interest groups the media and voters and the macro level aspects of campaigns such as campaign strategy and determinants of election outcomes the book concludes with a big picture assessment of campaign ethics and implications of the permanent campaign

originally published in 2000 the right to vote was widely hailed as a magisterial account of the evolution of suffrage from the american revolution to the end of the twentieth century in this revised and updated edition keyssar carries the story forward from the disputed presidential contest of 2000 through the 2008 campaign and the election of barack obama the right to vote is a sweeping reinterpretation of american political history as well as a meditation on the meaning of democracy in contemporary american life
